Travel and Accommodations

Washington State University and the University of Idaho will jointly host the 18th Inland Northwest Philosophy Conference. WSU and U of I are a mere 8 miles apart, and as such it is natural to think of the Pullman-Moscow area as one community.

Air Travel:

The Pullman-Moscow Regional Airport (PUW) serves the WSU/U of I area. Both the University Inn and the Residence Inn offer a free shuttle service to and from the airport.

In some cases, it may be more economical to fly in to Spokane International Airport (GEG). Wheatland Express offers a bus service to Moscow, ID and Pullman, WA for a nominal fee (\$38 each way).

By Car:

The conference itself will be held at the <u>Smith Center for Undergraduate Education</u> (CUE) in Pullman. The website for the CUE has a map insert that can provide more detailed driving directions. Parking is available at an hourly rate in the parking garage beneath the CUE. Refer to WSU's transportation <u>page</u> for alternative parking arrangements.

Accommodations:

Lodging can be obtained either in Pullman (closer to the conference site) or in Moscow (closer to the reception). We have set aside blocks of rooms at the following hotels:
