

He recently revised *Assessing and Correcting Reading and Writing Difficulties*, 2e (2002) and Creating Literacy *Instruction for All Children*, 4e (2003). The author wrote *Best Books for Beginning Readers* (1997), *Best Books for Building Literacy for Elementary School Children* (1999), *Building Words: A Resource Manual for Teaching Word Analysis and Spelling Skills and Strategies* (2001), and *Phonological Awareness and Primary Phonics* (2000).
