and there is
sent for and they are a going
to disarm the Indians and
if any resistance is made
they will be war - please
keep this news from the
Indians. in your part of the
country. as we should like to
keep every thing from them.
in times like these, about
10 Indians left the res-
for Lyanki yesterday by order
of Mr. Davison so I have
here I do not know their
Business they are Baracks.
hoping these lines will find
you well
